Protocol for Industry Notification of Pollution Incidents

Effective 6 February 2012 all NSW sites licensed with the EPA are required to **immediately notify each** of the relevant authorities when material harm to the environment is caused or threatened.

All the below authorities must be notified not just the appropriate regulatory authority

- Call 000 if the incident presents an immediate threat to human health or property. Fire and Rescue, the NSW Police and the NSW Ambulance are the first responders responsible for controlling and containing incidents.
- If the incident does not require an initial combat agency, or once the 000 call has been made, notify the relevant authorities in the following order:
